The Role of Dignity, Face, and Honor Cultural Logics in Intrapersonal, Interpersonal, and Intergroup Processes

DESCRIPTION: The distinction between cultural logics of dignity, face, and honor (DFH) is relatively new, but it is increasingly used to understand cultural differences in a variety of psychological processes spanning intrapersonal, interpersonal, and intergroup domains.

This special issue aims to bring together research on

- (1) the conceptualization, measurement, and prevalence of DHF logics across cultures,
- (2) country-, regional- and individual-level correlates and behavioral consequences of these cultural logics across intrapersonal, interpersonal, and intergroup domains, and
- (3) critical and integrative reviews of the literature on DHF logics.

We are eager to include papers (both original research and review articles) that include different levels of analysis, focus on new topics, introduce new theoretical perspectives and connect with existing ones in different fields of psychology, and make novel contributions to the literature. We are striving to have balance among the three different cultural logics across the published papers.

Submission information

We ask authors to submit an abstract (1,000 words or less) describing the topic of the research, the central questions asked, the research methods employed, the number and national origins of participants, the main results, and the significance of the findings. From these abstracts, the guest editors will make selections and request that authors of selected abstracts submit the complete manuscript for external review by 1 November 2024. All requested submissions will be sent for peer review by at least two independent reviewers.

Dates, Deadlines and Details

- 1 June 2024: Deadline for abstracts to be submitted to s.jabeen@elsevier.com with the words "DFH Cultural Logics Special Issue" in the subject line.
- 1 July 2024: Guest editors will make decisions about abstracts selected for full manuscript review
- 1 November 2024: Submission deadline for selected manuscripts
